## **SUMMER LEAGUE - CLASS 1 & PREMIER ONLY**

Please note the following Rules apply only to those specific sections of Women's Premier & Class 1 and Mens Class 1 listed. All existing DLTC Summer League Rules continue to apply, excluding the following sections for Class 1 and Premier only.

## **Nomination of Team**

- A For Women's Premier and Class 1 and Men's Class 1 teams, each team shall register their seven highest ranked available players on the DLTC System in Alphabetical Order, ignoring the DLTC System designation of Singles and Doubles. If the Club has more than one team in Premier and/or Class 1, the Club shall list their next seven highest ranked available players on the next team.
- B At the scheduled starting time of each match, all players must be present and each Team Captain shall separately write on a blank DLTC Summer League match result sheet, his/her seven players (nominated player or nominated substitute) in whatever order the Team Captain chooses. When completed, the Team Captains must exchange result sheets.
- C The Team Captains must exchange their respective complete sheets and the team shall play the events in the order as set out on the two match result sheets. No changes may be made once the team sheets have been exchanged.
- D Once the match is finished, both results sheets should be completed, checked for accuracy and signed by both Team Captains. The winning Club is responsible for inputting the match result details on the DLTC System.

## **Substitutes**

E When a substitute is brought in to play, this substitute can play at any position. As for other Classes, once a player has played for a higher team twice, they are no longer eligible to play for, or substitute for a team in a lower Class.

## Walkover

- F In the event of a team having less than seven players, walkovers will be given as below. If a team has less than seven players, the captain must share this information prior to any exchange of team sheets.
  - F(i) Only 6 players present walkover is given at 3rd singles
  - F(ii) Only 5 players present walkover is given at  $2^{nd}$  doubles <u>or</u>  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  singles
- G Fines for not having a full team present will be issued in accordance with normal DLTC procedures.
